I will be out of the country for the next three months but Eileen Drennan will fill in for me at guild meetings and also be collecting anything you bring to be donated.

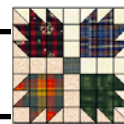

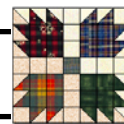

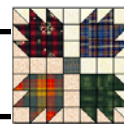

Bonnie K Hunter is passionate about quilting, focusing mainly on scrap quilts with the simple feeling of “making do.” She started her love affair with quilting in a home economics class her senior year of high school in 1980 and has never looked back. Before quilting became her full time career, Bonnie was the owner and designer of “Needle in a Haystack!!” creating over 70 patterns for dolls and stuffed animals with a country primitive feel. Many of her designs were licensed through the Butterick Pattern Company, translated into 7 languages, and sold around the globe through fabric stores.



But Quilting has always been Bonnie’s first love. She started machine quilting her quilts in 1988 and spent many years professionally long arm machine quilting for the public after purchasing her first long-arm machine in 1995. She has been featured in magazines both for her quilt patterns and articles she has written on scrap management and using that stash to it’s full potential.

Bonnie is dedicated to continuing the traditions of quilting. She enjoys meeting with quilters, teaching workshops and lecturing to quilt guilds all over the USA, challenging quilters to break the rules, think outside the box, and find what brings them joy.

Her first book, *Scraps & Shirrtails*, was released in 2008 followed by her second book, *Adventures With Leaders & Enders* released in early 2010, also published by Kansas City Star. Be on the look-out for *Scraps & Shirrtails II*, due for release in early 2011!

Bonnie writes a regular column for *Quiltmaker Magazine* entitled "Addicted to Scraps" with the main intention to help you to put various aspects of your own Scrap Users System to good use!

Her large website, [Quiltville.com](http://Quiltville.com) is visited by thousands of quilters around the globe daily, providing many with ideas for using those precious scraps, including free patterns to get you started!

Bonnie’s favorite motto? “The Best Things in Life are Quilted!!!” of course!

## Quilt Show 2012

As your new Quilt Show Chairman, I picked the theme of **“Quilts Across America, Binding Us Together”** for our 2012 show because I believe that everyone knows someone who quilts.

I believe if you were to stop and ask any person you meet, “Do you know anyone who quilts?”, they would say, “Yes” and then proceed to tell you who it is. It could be their grandmother, sister, aunt or someone else in their family tree. It might be their neighbor, co-worker, or friend. Everyone knows someone who quilts, hence “Quilts Across America”.

The Chairman’s Choice quilt challenge for the 2012 show is to make a quilt that represents a specific state in America. That’s 50 quilts or 51 if someone wants to choose Washington DC. This is a big Chairman’s Choice challenge! Here are the rules:

1. The maximum size is 40”X40”.
2. The shape of your quilt does not have to be a square or a rectangle. It can be any shape you choose as long as it does not exceed 40” x 40”.

3. It can be made by an individual or a group.
4. You can use any symbol that YOU think represents your particular state. It could be the flower, the bird, the song, the tree, the motto, or even the most prominent sports team, theme park or major landmark in that State, (i.e. Mount Rushmore, Statue of Liberty, Disney World or the Nebraska Cornhuskers).

Use your imagination! I want to see all the creativity we have in this Guild and I know there is a lot of that! If you need ideas, I found a bunch of state information on the website:

[www.50states.com](http://www.50states.com). Enjoy doing some research and then we will all be smarter for learning about our beautiful 50 States! These are the states that still have no one to represent them as of Jan 25<sup>th</sup>.
